ACHIEVEMENT'S IN CO-CURRICULUM



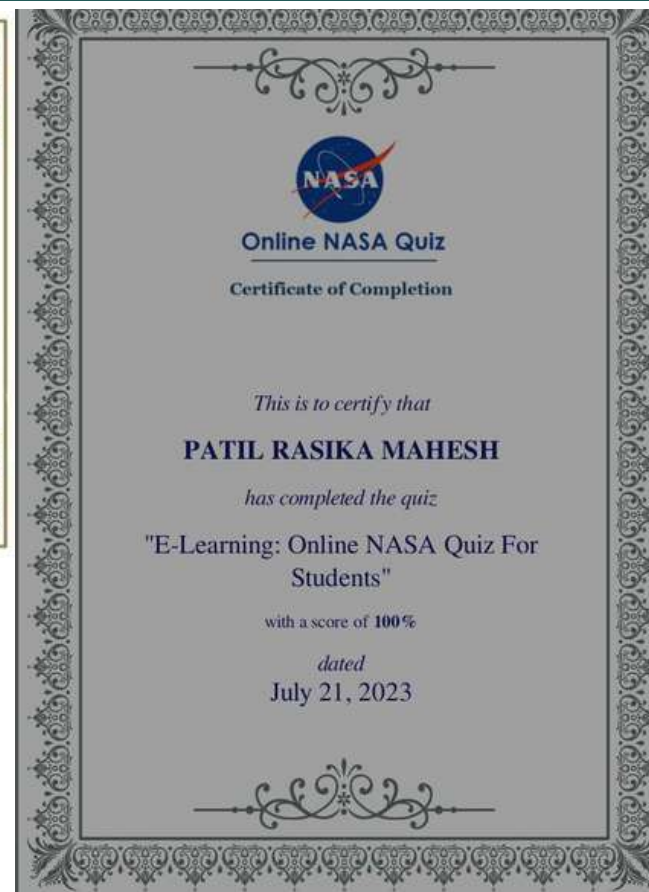
